Background: how relational are port studies?

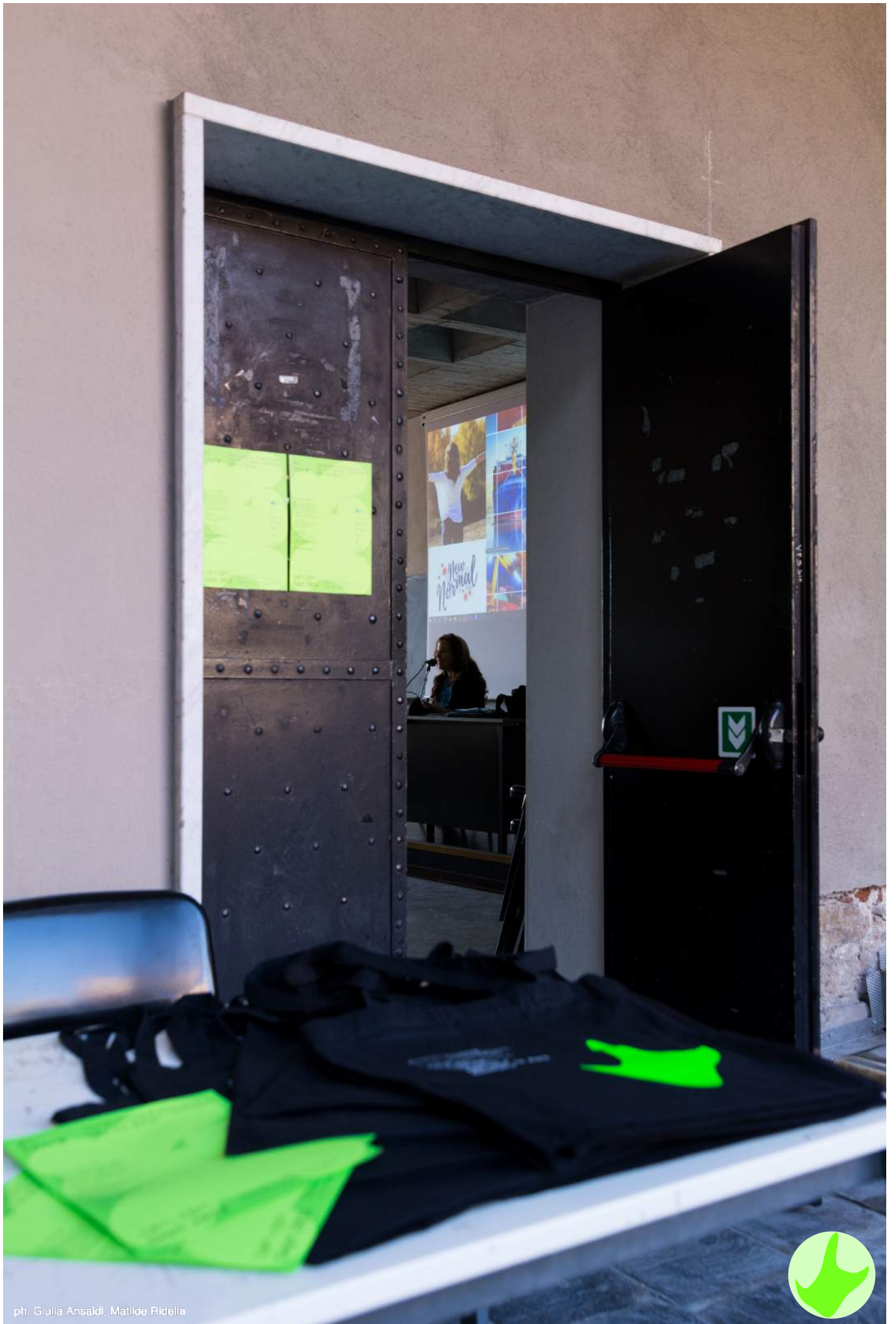
- (Trans)port geography in the 1950s-1960s: spatial models, graph theory, infrastructures, cities, interregional flow matrices, spatial analysis / quantitative geography, regional planning
- Keeling (1995): transport geography carries the risk of « being confined in the dark corners of networks and flows »
- Relational turn #1 (1970s-1990s): actors, strategies, planning, policies, globalisation
- Relational turn #2 (2000s-): complex networks, social network analysis

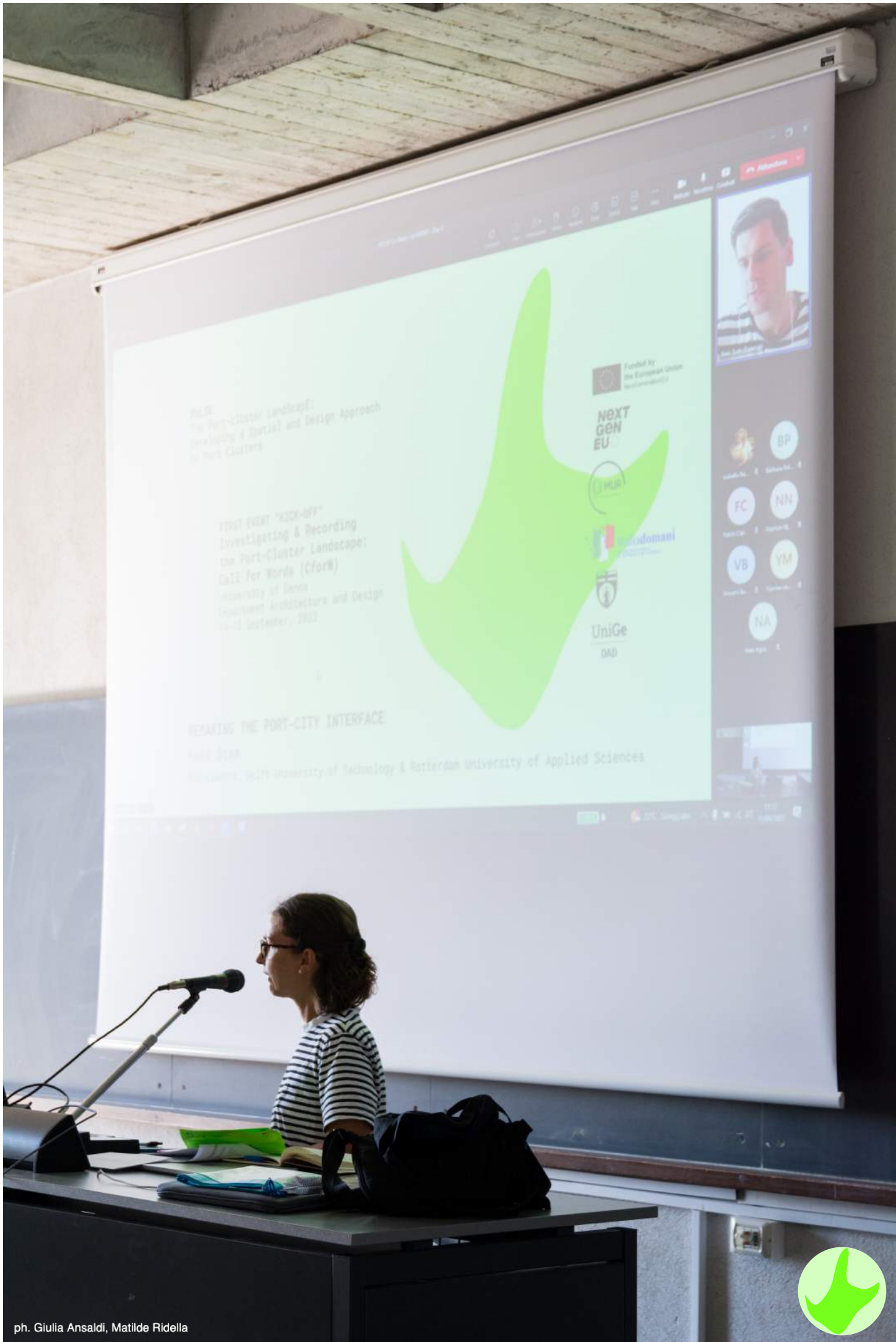

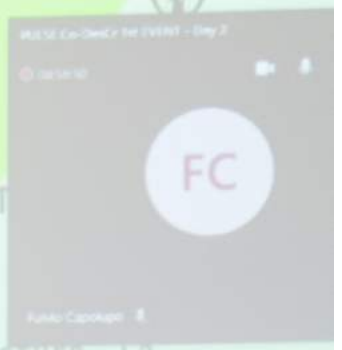
